As a teenager, Lady J performed with **Johnnie Johnson** (Father of Rock 'n Roll piano with Chuck Berry); then toured as Trumpeter, Vocalist, & Music Director with Rock 'n Roll & Blues Hall of Famer, <u>Albert "Blues Boy" King</u>, performing on concerts with legends such as: *B.B. King, Robert Cray, Millie Jackson, John Lee Hooker, Muddy Waters, Albert Collins, Etta James,* & more. They filmed a Dick Clark TV special and a live concert on PBS, "Maintenance Shop Blues".

- Eady J returned to her roots of St. Louis, MO due to a health crisis in 2013. She resumed her musical ministry in churches, then debuted the "The Lady J Huston Show & Tribute to Albert King" at the National Blues Museum (NBM) in 2018. Lady J wows audiences as a soloist, duo, multiple sized bands, to an 18-piece big band orchestra. She's headlined in Concert Halls, Showrooms, Festivals, & a multitude of venues. Her Blues recording infused with Jazz & R&B "Hide-Away" is featured on the St. Louis Blues Society's "18 in 18" compilation CD accompanied by a classy music video. Lady J won the NBM 2020 songwriting competition for "Corona You Make Me Sick!. This hot record & anthem was released in 2021 & has become a fan favorite with its uplifting music video. In her advocacy to help support efforts to end the pandemic, she has been featured on KMOV (CBS) Evening News, a PSA produced by Mercy Hospital, an Associated Press news article, & more.
